

1. StoGuard® Joint Treatment options:

- a. StoGuard® RapidFill
- (joints $\leq 1/4$ inch [6 mm])

(joints $\leq 1/8$ inch [3 mm])

- b. Sto Gold Fill® with StoGuard®
- Mesh (joints ≤ 1/8 inch [3 mm])
- c. StoGuard® Fabric with StoGuard® air and moisture barrier
- 2. StoGuard® air and moisture barrier options:
 - a. Sto Gold Coat® (vapor permeable)
 - b. Sto EmeraldCoat® (high perm)
 - c. Sto VaporSeal™(vapor impermeable)
 - d. Sto AirSeal™ (high perm) (Not for use with Sto Guard Fabric)
- 3. The maximum thickness of foam plastic insulation allowed by code is typically 4" (100mm).
- 4. The exposed surface must have a minimum slope of 1:2 (27°). In locations where ice and snow may accumulate, increase the slope.
- 5. Provide Sto Flexyl[™] and mesh on upper surfaces of foam features projecting more than 2" (50mm) from the stucco surface. Feather edges into
