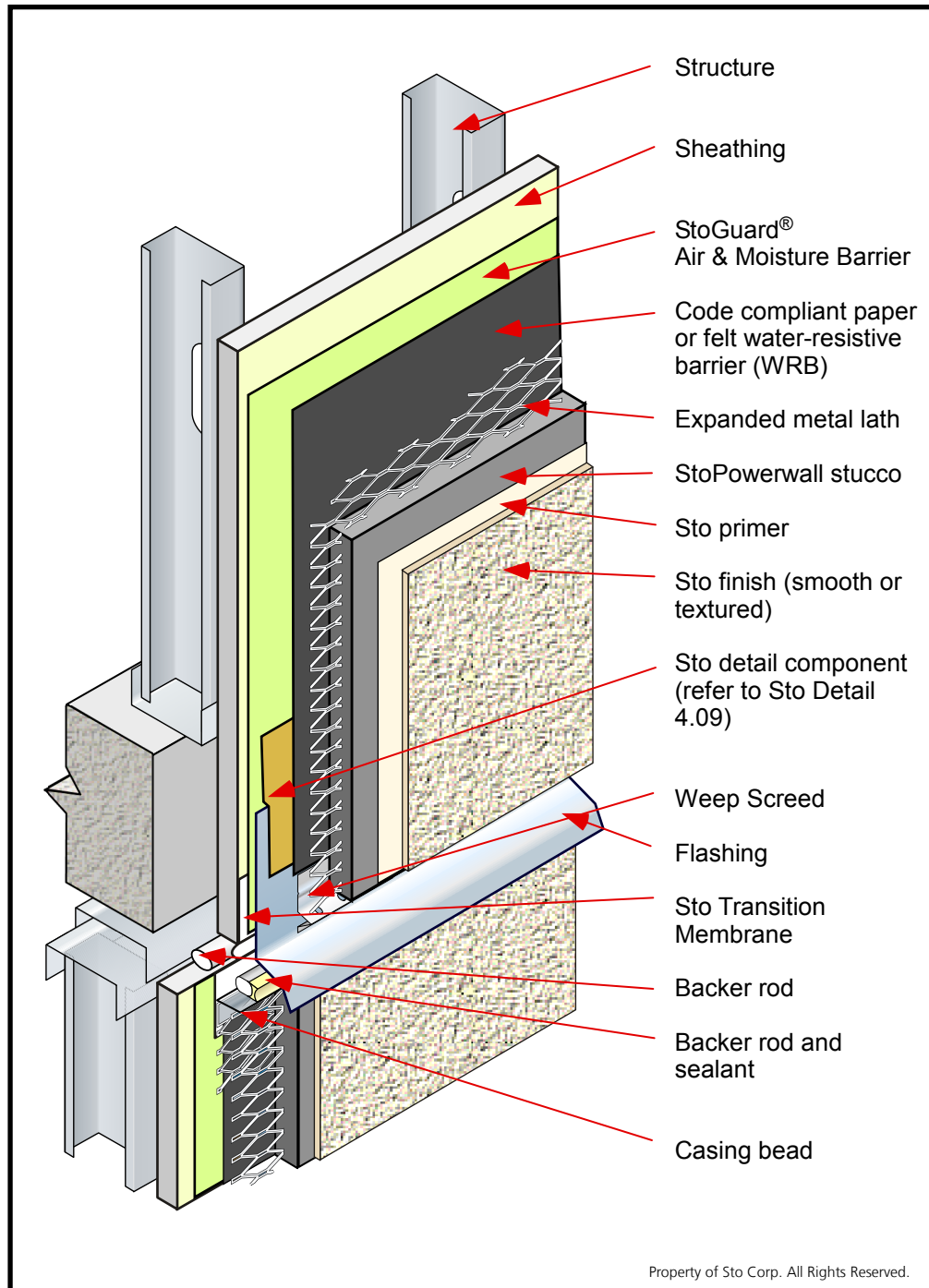


# StoPowerwall® Floor Line Joint with Nested Track

Detail No.: 4.50

Date: December 2015



## Notes:

- 1] Do not attach upper sheathing to nested track. Only attach lower sheathing to nested track.
- 2] The maximum allowable sheathing span at the floor line is 8" (200mm) or as recommended by the sheathing manufacturer.
- 3] Sto Transition Membrane is installed over the joint in the sheathing to provide air barrier continuity and secondary weather protection at the joint location.
- 4] Provide a minimum 3/4" (20mm) joint to accommodate deflection of the floor slab.
- 5] Install a flashing to direct water beyond the face of the cladding below.
- 6] See detail 4.01 for StoGuard product options
