In just two years after painting, the vibrant green color was fading badly at the top of the Honda Center in Anaheim, California.

The Honda Center stands as one of the premier entertainment and sports venues in the country. Opening in 1993, the venue is owned by the City of Anaheim and managed by Anaheim Arena Management, LLC. The 650,000 square foot building, with a capacity to seat 18,000 plus, was in need of TLC.

Sto's area representative drove by the arena one day and noticed that the green was no longer bright. The arena was originally built with StoTherm Classic NExt[®], an EIFS product with an air and moisture barrier. The city changed the color scheme and had a painting contractor repaint it with another company's paint. They were told it would not fade. Sto's rep talked to the director of operations and told them Sto had the solution. After more than a year of making samples and presentations, Sto received the okay to proceed and brought in MC Painting, an applicator in southern California.

The work was done on the upper level of the five story building. "The building looked horrible," said Michael Lewis, President of MC Painting. "Some of the panels were even delaminating. We replaced some of the panels and patched up the building."

After the repair work was complete, an acrylic textured wall finish was applied before it was repainted. The building is now refinished, repainted and again shines in Anaheim.
